
Memory Boxes

Festive Cranberry Cake

Ingredients:

3/4 cup butter, softened

1 cup sugar

2 large eggs, room temperature

2-1/4 cups all-purpose flour

1 teaspoon baking powder

1 teaspoon baking soda

1 cup buttermilk

1 cup fresh or frozen cranberries

1 cup chopped dates

1 cup chopped pecans

Glaze:

1/2 cup orange juice

1/4 cup sugar

Optional: Sugared cranberries and rosemary sprigs

Directions:

Preheat oven to 350°. In a bowl, cream butter and sugar. Add eggs; beat well. Combine dry ingredients; add to creamed mixture alternately with buttermilk. Stir in cranberries, dates and pecans. Spread in a greased and floured 10-in. tube pan. Bake until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean, 60-70 minutes. Cool in pan for 10 minutes. Meanwhile, for glaze, heat orange juice and sugar in a small saucepan until sugar dissolves. Invert cake onto a serving plate. With a toothpick, punch holes in cake. Spoon glaze over cake. Cover and refrigerate for at least 8 hours. If desired, top with sugared cranberries and rosemary.

Buttermilk

To substitute for each cup of buttermilk, use 1 Tbsp. white vinegar or lemon juice plus enough milk to measure 1 cup. Stir, then let stand 5 min. Or use 1 cup plain yogurt or 1-3/4 teaspoon cream of tartar plus 1 cup milk.

Sugared Cranberries

Heat 3 tablespoons light corn syrup in microwave until warm; gently toss with 1 cup fresh or frozen cranberries, allowing excess syrup to drip off. Toss in 1/3 cup sugar to coat. Place on waxed paper; let stand until set, about 1 hour.
