

Cinnamon Sugar Apple Cake

Ingredients

Apple Cake:

- 1 1/2 cups brown sugar
- 1/3 cup **oil**
- 1 egg
- 1 cup **buttermilk** or (1 cup milk + 1 tablespoon white vinegar)
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 2 1/2 cups **flour**
- 2 1/2 cups chopped Honeycrisp apples

Cinnamon Sugar Topping:

- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1 tablespoon **butter**, melted

Instructions

- 1. Preheat oven to 325 degrees. Mix or whisk ingredients in order given, stirring until just combined. Fold in your apples.
- 2. Pour batter into a buttered 9×13 pan (alternatively, you can line with parchment paper).
- 3. Combine last 3 ingredients to make a topping and sprinkle / spread it evenly over the batter.
- 4. Bake for 45 minutes. Test with a toothpick if needed. Serve with honey butter or whipped cream if you want.
