President's Message

Dear Friends,

It is the beginning of a New Year with fresh things to look forward to. As I mentioned in the January president's letter, we have scheduled beautiful projects for our paint-ins. I hope you have had the opportunity to look them over and plan which ones you will paint. For one of the projects, we will use "quikwood," and in another project, we will use colored pencils. I have only used these mediums once, and they presented a challenge for me. I look forward to painting these projects to help improve my skills in these mediums.

Most of us look forward to a challenge when we take on a new project. It may be that the piece calls for stroke work or line work we are unfamiliar with; it may call for different-shaped leaves or flowers we have not painted before. Anything new usually presents a challenge; however, practice is essential to mastering a skill. Our monthly paint-ins allow students to practice and improve their skills as artists.

Monthly paint-ins also offer us the opportunity to paint with various teachers. As you know, each teacher has a different method of teaching and different ways of painting. From my experience, almost every time I paint with a teacher, I learn something new: it might be a different way of shading, a new way to make dots without that bubble in the center, or a new brush to use to accomplish a technique. Whatever it may be, there is always something to learn at a paint-in. As we begin this new year, let us challenge ourselves to practice more and become more proficient in painting.

Your SCDP Board began the New Year by putting together the budget for our Club. Budget planning was quite a task, but we finished it and will present it at our General Meeting in February. As you know, our General Meetings always began at 9:30 am before each paint-in. This year, we have decided that our General Meetings will begin at 9:00 am, allowing us to start our paint-ins at the scheduled time, 9:30 am. Everyone agreed that this would be a good change. We will continue to award a "free" paint-in to one lucky member in attendance at the General Meeting.

Looking forward to seeing you at our paint-ins, and Happy Valentine's Day,




