
### <u> Memory Box Report</u>

#### **Memory Boxes**

Another year of painting memory boxes for our community service project is in the books. A big thanks to those members who painted boxes in 2023. We completed and delivered a total of 82 memory boxes to Long Beach Memorial Hospital. At the beginning of the year, I had set a goal of 70 boxes and we far surpassed that number, with several members painting multiple boxes. I am grateful for the dedication our members have to this most worthwhile program that our group has participated in for over 22 years. I delivered 11 boxes to the hospital on December 14 and the Chaplain, Reverend Candace Kelly, asked me to pass along the following message to our group "Please know you are making an incredible difference in our patient's hospitalization". It's nice to know that us painters, by doing what we love to do, and simply painting a memory box can show a moment of caring and comfort to a grieving family.

Going forward in 2024, we will continue to have quarterly Zoom memory box paint-alongs on the following dates: February 5, April 1, August 5 and October 7, 2024. These paint-alongs are on Monday mornings beginning at 9:30 am and end at 12 noon. I will be emailing a pattern to our members in mid-January for the February paint-along in case you are in need of one. As I have mentioned in previous articles, if you are local and in need of unpainted boxes, or have completed boxes to turn in, please contact me and arrangements will be made to pick up or drop off. Remember, as part of our membership in SCDP, we pledge to paint one memory box per year. Thank you for your continued support!
