





We are painting our way into the Holidays!


We had our elf hats on in November!

#### See's Fudge - And yes, I was always told it's really from See's Candy

41/2 cups gran. Sugar

3 pkg chocolate chips - 12oz.

7 oz. marshmallow whip

2 tsp. Vanilla

1/2lbs. butter

2 cups chopped walnuts (or nuts of you choice, or leave out)

1tsp. Salt

1 lg. can of Pet Milk

Have most ingredients ready in large bowl, excluding milk & sugar.

Heat milk & sugar to a rolling boil on low heat. Cook 6 min, stirring constantly, pour into other ingredients,

Mix & work fast until all mixed together. When blended pour into a jellyroll sheet pan. Sets up fast, but not hard. Will stay semi soft. If it's too soft to stay into cut pieces, I roll it into balls, still tastes yummy!

It makes 5lbs. It's very yummy! I hope everyone loves it like I do.
