





#### Strawberry Stuffed French Toast Bake

#### Ingredients:

- 4 large eggs
- 1 cup whole milk
- 1-2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- ½ teaspoon kosher salt
- 6 croissants, sliced
- 8 ounces whipped cream cheese, at room temperature
- ⅓ cup strawberry jam
- 3 tablespoons melted salted butter, plus more for the pan
- 2 tablespoons brown sugar
- 2 tablespoons real maple syrup
- 1 cup fresh strawberries, sliced
- Strawberry whipped cream for serving.

#### Directions:

- 1. Preheat the oven to 375° F.
- 2. Grease a 9 x 13 baking pan with a little melted butter.
- 3. In a large shallow dish, whisk together the eggs, milk and vanilla extract.
- 4. Stir together the cream cheese and strawberry jam. Spoon the mixture onto the bottom half of the cut croissants. Place the tops on the croissants and cut each into 4 pieces.
- 5. Arrange the pieces croissants on the prepared 9 x 13 baking dish. Pour the egg mixture over the croissants in an even layer. Making sure to coat each of them.
- 6. Bake for 25 minutes or until the croissant is golden.
- 7. Mix the melted butter, brown sugar, and maple syrup. Spoon the mixture evenly over each croissant. Bake another 10 minutes, until the croissants are caramelized on top and crisp.
- 8. Top with whipped strawberry cream and fresh sliced strawberries.
- 9. YUM!
