


All members of SCDP join our pledge in painting at least one Memory Box per year.


NEW WEBSITE for SCDP

IRISH COFFEE CAKE

Ingredients

1/2 cup unsalted butter, room temp
1/2 cup light brown sugar
1/4 cup granulated sugar
1/4 cup Greek yogurt, room temp
1/2 Baileys Irish Cream
2 teaspoon vanilla extract
2 large eggs, room temp
2 cups all-purpose flour
2 teaspoon baking powder
1/2 teaspoon baking soda
1/2 teaspoon salt

Streusel

³/₄ cup all-purpose flour
³/₄ cup light brown sugar
2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
4 tablespoon unsalted butter, melted
1 tablespoon Baileys Irish Cream

Irish Cream Glaze

¹/₄ cup powdered sugar1 tablespoon Baileys Irish Cream

Instructions

In a large mixing bowl, beat together butter and sugars until combined, 2-3 minutes. Add Greek yogurt, Irish cream & vanilla extract. Beating until smooth. Beat in eggs, one at a time.

Add flour, baking powder, baking soda & sale, mix until just combined.

Mix the flour, sugar & cinnamon in a medium bowl. Add the melted butter, Irish cream, mix until combined.

Preheat oven to 350° F. Grease an 8x8 baking pan. Pour in half the batter, spreading to all corners. Top with half the streusel mix. Pour remaining batter over top & add remaining streusel mix.

Bake for 40-50 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in the middle comes out clean.

While cake is cooling, make the glaze. Whisk together the powdered sugar & Irish cream until combined. Drizzle over Cake after it has cooled for 15 minutes and serve.
