


#### **SEMINAR UPDATE**

#### **MEMORY BOX PROGRAM**


As you may know, SCDP paints Memory Boxes that are donated to Long Beach Memorial Hospital for parents that have lost babies at birth. SCDP has painted and donated boxes for many years as one of our charitable causes and in 2022, 71 boxes were donated and delivered to Long Beach Memorial. Great job ladies! Unfortunately, there continues to be a need for painted boxes for the parents to place a blanket, lock of hair, hospital bracelet, or any other memento. SCDP members, as part of their membership, pledge to paint at least one memory box per year. Beginning in February 2023, we will be holding a quarterly Memory Box Paint-along. Our first paint-along will be Monday, February 6, 2023, from 9:30 am-12 Noon on Zoom. Along with painting memory boxes together this will allow members to stay in contact since we are not meeting in person. In case you are in need of a pattern, I have attached "Home Tweet Home", a free pattern designed by Renee Mullins that has been painted on Memory Boxes in the past. I have included two different sized line drawings and hopefully one of them will fit your surface. #### BELIEFS ABOUT VALENTINE'S DAY

Tradition has it that Valentine's Day came about to be

celebrated because of St. Valentine. St. Valentine was a priest in the early Church. Legend has it that Emperor Claudius had outlawed marriage because single men made better soldiers than married men. St. Valentine took pity on the young lovers and married them even though it was not permitted. It is believed that in the 18th century, Valentine's Day began to be celebrated.

The first Valentine's day cards were sent out during this period and were originally handmade. The person making these cards would decorate the paper with romantic symbols and write some poetry. Some remained anonymous; others would address it to "My Valentine."

Red Wine Beef Ragu



#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 1/2 c. dry red wine
- 3 tbsp. tomato paste
- **2 tbsp.** flour
- 1 tbsp. balsamic vinegar
- 1 medium onion
- 4 clove garlic
- **6** sprig fresh thyme
- 1 can whole peeled tomatoes
- 2 lb. lean brisket
- kosher salt
- Pepper
- **12 oz.** Pasta
- fresh basil
- grated Parmesan

#### DIRECTIONS

STEP 1 In a 5- to 6-quart slow cooker, whisk together the wine, tomato paste, flour, and vinegar. Stir in the onion, garlic, and thyme. Add the tomatoes, crushing them with your hands.

STEP 2 Cut the brisket against the grain into 3-inch-thick pieces, then cut those pieces in half crosswise. Season them with 1/2 teaspoon each salt and pepper and nestle in the sauce. Cover and cook until the meat is tender and easily pulls apart, 6 to 7 hours on high or 8 to 9 hours on low.

STEP 3 Twenty minutes before the ragu is finished, cook the pasta according to package directions.

STEP 4 Discard the thyme and, using two forks, break the meat into smaller pieces. Serve over the pasta and top with basil and cheese, if desired.
